Course Description

- In Pre-Algebra, each student will be working on an individualized instructional plan using the Accelerated Math program. Topics will be selected based on student need with the goal of preparing each student for Algebra I next year.

Grading:

- Your grade will consist of tests and daily work according to the following percentages:

Tests	50%
Daily Work	<u>50%</u>
	100%

- Your grades will be updated each week.
- You may view your grades on the internet using the Infinite Campus program.
- The grading scale is printed in your student handbook.

Daily Work:

- Every day, you will earn a grade based on your level of effort. If you work hard, you will earn the full 2 points. If you do not work hard, you will earn less. It is expected that you show work on all assignments. Effort level will be determined through observation by Mrs. Erskine and/or Mrs. Darrah.

Tests:

- Tests will be administered regularly as students complete objectives.
- Students must achieve 80% correct to pass a test.
- Students will re-take each test until it is passed. In the event of a re-take, the first test score will be dropped. All re-take scores will be averaged for the final test grade.

Absences:

- Students will receive a zero daily work grade for all absences (school activities, excused, and unexcused).
- Students will be assigned make-up work for all absences. Successful completion of make-up work will earn full daily work points for the days missed.
- Absent work is to be made up as homework, not during class time.
